



Simulator Information

The Vault, Dellwood's state-of-the-art Trackman Golf Simulator, is open and available for both Golf and Athletic Members. Golf Members can sign up on Foretees up to14 days in advance. Athletic Members have reservation access 3 days in advance. Junior Golf Members (16 & Under) to be accompanied by their parent.

The simulator fee is \$35 per/hour Monday-Thursday, and \$45 Friday-Sunday. Members wishing to invite guests are billed \$10/guest. Please note we have introduced a Cancellation Policy this year, which is created to optimize the availability of The Vault and provide as much access as possible. If you're not able to use your reservation, **please cancel within three hours** to avoid a fee equal to 50% of the cost of the reserved time.

Members can sign up for 1 hour per player and up to 4 hours with 4 players. To plan your tee times, please reference the following guidelines: Allow 30 mins for each player to play 9 holes. (Ex: 1 person plays 18 holes in 1 hour. And 4 people play 9 holes in 2 hours.)

Trackman is universally accepted as the best product on the market. It's many features include:

*200+ Golf courses available to play. Courses feature lots of different tee options with many also having junior tees available.

* Work on your game with Trackman's shot analysis which features over 30 data points about your swing. The shot analysis is available on the virtual driving range or you can do on-course practice on any hole of the 200+ courses.

* Lessons on the Trackman are also available during the winter. We are highly skilled in using the Trackman for teaching. This can be a good way to improve your game during the long winter months. You can set up a lesson by calling the golf shop or by e-mailing Clayton, Cory, or Drew.

The golf shop has been restocked with some new lines of clothing for both men, women, and juniors. We have also restocked the popular UNRL Hoodies in the last couple of weeks and have included kids' sizes now. Make sure to stop in and get your Christmas shopping done here at Dellwood.

I am looking forward to showcasing several new seasonal cocktails this winter!

Recently, I have been experimenting with various flavor combinations to create balanced cocktails reminiscent of the winter season. Rosemary paired with lemon, sage with blueberry, and browned butter with toasted pecan, to name a few.

A new addition to our cocktail menu, the Nutty Professor features a brown butter fat-washed Makers Mark whiskey (which you must taste before passing judgment based on the description) made in-house. This process gives the whiskey a slightly thicker mouthfeel and a hint of sweetness.



Paired with a homemade toasted pecan simple syrup, this Old Fashioned is NUTS!

Our maintenance staff has been busy finishing up fall cleanup and complete some projects. This fall cleanup really sets the stage for a much easier spring prep. This is also the time we prepare the golf course for winter by blowing out our irrigation system and spraying plant protectants to keep the turf from getting Snow Mold. Both our grounds staff along with Drew and Josh from the golf staff put in some solid days of filling divots on tees and fairways. Thanks to them for their help! We were able to complete some early tree removals, some irrigation repair, clubhouse drainage and plant some trees near the Clubhouse and on the golf course before our last big snow fall.

As we transition into winter mode, look for the opening of the sledding hill, the ice rink, and the cross country ski trail and as always snow shoeing. The ski trail will be groomed

this week and we will start on the ice rink next week. Other winter activities for our staff will include snow removal, tree trimming and removals, equipment repair and maintenance, accessory maintenance and the on going maintenance of the rink and ski trail.


